e7 is a unique jobs program created by the Prop. A/AA Bond Program. It is composed of three parts, each of which is designed to help people into the work force.

The **e7 Internship Program** is designed to connect LACCD students with internship opportunities available at firms that provide products and services to the nine LACCD colleges under the Proposition A/AA Bond Program.

The **e7 Architecture Studio** provides opportunities for hands-on professional development for LACCD students, as e7 interns, who are completing related coursework at one of the nine L.A. Community Colleges. The e7 Studio is under the interdisciplinary direction of architects, artists, programmers, designers, educators and GIS experts.

The third aspect of e7 is **PVJobs**, a nonprofit organization providing job placement services and opportunities for disadvantaged youth and adults. PVJobs is partnering with the Los Angeles Community College District on its \$2.2 billion Bond construction program to improve and expand the nine Los Angeles Community Colleges.
