



Now under construction, and expected to be completed in April 2007, the new Athletic Field / Parking Structure is an innovative solution to the issue of limited space at City College's urban campus. The new parking structure will accommodate more than 950 parking spaces, in addition to the campus' new Maintenance and Operations facility. The roof of the parking structure will house the new athletic field for the campus, which will include a softball and soccer field in addition to an eight-lane track, and will also accommodate other track and field sports.

LOS ANGELES CITY COLLEGE

This year's projects included the completion of the temporary Child Development Center – "temporary" because construction is planned to begin on a new Child Development Center in October.
