



To prepare for growth at Mission College, a new parking structure is under construction. Slated for completion in March 2007, it will contain 1,200 parking spaces and will feature photovoltaic cell arrays on the roof.

Mission College is located in the northeast San Fernando Valley in Sylmar. Visitors to Mission College will see a newly painted Instructional Building and a 3-story, 1200 space parking structure under construction. The parking structure will feature rooftop photovoltaic cells that will provide energy to the campus power grid and shade for the top floor of parking. Los Angeles Mission College is also working to update its campus master plan and has engaged local neighbors and community groups to help in the planning process. This is a new beginning for Mission College and a time to take the best features of the original master plan and build on them to create an even better master plan that will serve Mission College and the local community well for years to come.
